

# Flywheel Data LLC General Flow-downs

Last Updated: 12/2025

The referenced clauses are set forth or referred to in the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS), or NASA Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (NFS). These are incorporated by reference and shall predominate in the event of conflict with any other provision of the purchase order or agreement in which there are references to the “Purchase Order” unless specifically noted.

## Definitions

- *Government* shall mean any federal, state or local entity which is not public or privately owned entity or firm
- *Contract* shall mean the Purchase Order
- *Contractor* shall mean Flywheel Data or, the purchasing entity, not a Government agency
- *Contracting Officer* shall mean Prime Contractor Contracts Point of Contact (POC) or Government’s Contracting Authority
- *Products or Services* shall mean either or combination of products and services being purchased from Seller as part of the Purchase Order
- *Seller* shall mean the organization from which Flywheel Data is purchasing products and/or services (e.g. *Distributor, OEM, Contractor, Subcontractor, 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Reseller, etc.*)

These flow-down clauses, unless otherwise negotiated or exempt, are applicable to all Flywheel Data Purchase Order(s) unless otherwise specified herein:
